**IMPORTANT NOTES (please read)**

**MINI JUNIORS: For 2012 only** – Mini Juniors pay \$70 regardless of what the fee structure is on the computer (The new online Membership and Event Management Data Base)

**UPGRADES:** No Charge.

**PONY CLUB MEMBERS:** Pony Club members MUST BE REGISTERED MANUALLY, DIRECTLY WITH THE QPA (Name, Address, DOB and PC Rego number are required)

**FAMILY DISCOUNT:** The 10% Family discount is applicable under the following long standing guidelines:

- 1) Can be of various combinations of 3 or more FULL PAYING members of the one IMMEDIATE family. (senior, Intermediates & juniors only)
- 2) Can not claim discount for members outside the IMMEDIATE FAMILY
- 3) All must reside under the same roof
- 4) IMMEDIATE FAMILY constitutes any of the following: Spouse, parent, sibling, or child. The family one is born into. (DOES NOT INCLUDE MEMBERS OUTSIDE THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY)
- 5) There is NO DISCOUNT on Trial and Casual players
- 6) Mini Juniors are not eligible for family discount
- 7) Casual Players are not eligible for family discount
- 8) Trial players are not eligible for family discount
- 9) The family, must apply to the QPA (in writing) for a refund after the fees are paid and the members are financial.

**JUNIOR AGE SPECIFICATIONS:** Under 16 as at midnight 31/12 (refer page 37 of the rule book)  
 eg: If someone turns 16 on 1st Jan 2012, they can play Juniors in 2012 (because at midnight on 31/12 they were still 15) however if they are 16 at midnight 31/12/2011 they can not play as a junior in 2012 as they will turn 17 during that year.

**SOCIAL MEMBERS:** It is a condition of our insurance policy that social members must be covered and MUST pay a minimum of \$1.00. Social members fees are retained by the club. **ALL Social Members must be registered on line by their club.** These include non playing coaches, office bearers and umpires. All must complete the online waiver.

**NEW By Law** – (Effective 2009) Any club to be found playing unregistered players will be stood down until after the next tournament in their zone or penalized \$500. This By Law is a direct result of clubs allowing unregistered, uninsured players to play the sport.

**LIABILITY WAIVERS** - These are now completed on-line when every member pays their fees
